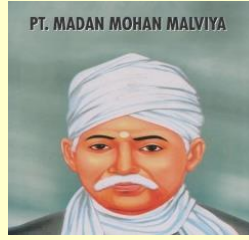

## About CIHTS

Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies (Deemed University) (CIHTS) at Sarnath, Varanasi, is one of its kinds in the country. The Institute was established in 1967. The idea of the Institute was mooted in course of a dialogue between Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India and His Holiness the Dalai Lama with a view to educating the young Tibetan Diaspora and those from the Himalayan border regions of India, who have religion, culture and language in common with Tibet. Originally the Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies (CIHTS), began to function as a constituent wing of the Sampurnananda Sanskrit University, and eventually emerged as an autonomous body in 1977 under the Department of Culture, Ministry of Education, Government of India.

## About Programme

The cornerstone of any education system is teachers, and the quality of education, is both determined and dependent on the quality of its teachers. The present higher education system focuses only on the Domain (subject) knowledge of the faculty. It does not focus on teaching-learning process, pedagogical Contents and its various tools which are very vital to develop the quality of learning experience in the education system.

Induction Programmes under PMMMNMTT aim to develop four possible types of skills among teachers personal (*interpersonal skills, career development, and life planning issues*); instructional (*course design and development, instructional technology*); organisational (*ways to improve the institutional environment to better support teaching*) and professional (*ways to support faculty members so that they fulfil their multiple roles of teaching, research, and service*)

## Eligibility

For Induction Programmes Newly recruited faculty members from Universities, Colleges, NITs, IIITs, Engineering Colleges and other Institutions of Higher Education from any stream are eligible.

## Programme Schedule

30.01.2019 to 28.02.2019 (30 days)

## Registration

The hard copy of duly filled Registration Form (attached) may be submitted to Centre for Teacher Education, CIHTS, Sarnath, Varanasi on or before the last date (20.01.2019).

## Instructions for the Participants

1. The application form must be duly forwarded through the Head of the Institution.
2. Attendance at all sessions is mandatory. Lunch and Tea shall be provided.
3. Outstation candidates will be reimbursed travelling expenses of III-tier AC rail ticket or AC bus fare on submission of tickets as per the rules.
4. Induction Programme is residential. Outstation participants will be provided accommodation and meals.
